

## Paving Town Hall Meeting

October 24<sup>th</sup> at 10 AM

Pinestone Clubhouse

Meeting was brought to order and chaired by Ed Wambold at 10 am.

There were approximately 36 people in attendance.

Board of Directors Update:

1. Accepted Karins Engineering # 1 paving option. Mill out travel areas and replace with 2 inches of asphalt pavement. Place a 1 inch asphalt pavement overlay under the carports.
2. Perform paving in 2018 with costs between \$363 – 400,000

Presented various aspects of our parking. Discussion on concrete and recycled plastic wheel stops, handicap parking, bollards (posts) in front of the Clubhouse versus wheel stops.

Coordination of painting, roofing and paving. Dust from milling?

Ending survey:

1. Pinestone should have wheel stops after paving is done.
2. Place stops only where buildings and electrical panels are to be “protected” (minimize)
3. Recycled stops to be gray with some support to be white (very open item)
4. Do not use volunteers, have contractors finish everything including wheel stops.
5. Should we widen the exit turn by the recycled water supply line? 9 yes and 14 no (open item)

Suggestion then made to table item 5 to put into a full study of the total entrance and exit issues (Facilities committee) Several areas where tree roots have raised pavement – cut off the roots!
